FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: The Holy Spirit is not easy to describe. Like a bird in flight it resists capture. Nevertheless, we must try. The Dominican theologian, Herbert McCabe, puts it very simply. By the Holy Spirit we mean God as eternally breathed forth by the Father and the Son. The idea of the Holy Spirit as 'breath' is rooted in the Scriptures. In the Hebrew Bible the word for spirit is 'ruach,' a word of complex meaning which also translates as breath or wind. It is the same word as that used in the book of Genesis, in the very making of humankind: "God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and the man became a living being" (Genesis 2:7). God's breath brings life. In John's Gospel "Pentecost" occurs on Easter Eve, when Jesus appears to the frightened disciples with a greeting of peace. These disciples had abandoned Jesus at his arrest and fled in fear. Jesus forgives them. Though they had abandoned Jesus, he will not abandon them. Then, just like God's action at creation, Jesus breathes on them, saying "Receive the Holy Spirit." The Spirit empowers the disciples and moves them outward in mission, persecution does not destroy but stimulates the community of disciples to proclaim the Gospel with courage and boldness. Especially in the Acts of the Apostles we see how the Spirit becomes the energizing presence as the Church moves outward to the ends of the earth. The disciples are no longer afraid because they know that God's spirit has come down on them and will never leave them orphans.
