FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Jesus' discourse in Mark 13 is often called the "Little Apocalypse," as opposed to the "Great Apocalypse" found in the book of Revelation. An apocalypse is a revelation about the future or about the heavenly realm. The discourse is divided into four parts and the gospel today includes the third part and most of the fourth part. Using terms taken from various parts of the Old Testament, Jesus describes the cosmic portents that will lead up to the triumphant manifestation of the glorious Son of Man and the vindication of the "elect." Next Jesus presents an exhortation consisting of parables and sayings, with some mixed messages ("this generation...nobody knows"). Yet, he urges confidence in God's plan and constant vigilance as the divine plan unfolds and reaches its climax in the fullness of God's kingdom. Given Jesus' instructions to be vigilant, how might such watchfulness influence the way a Christian lives?
