ONLINE MASS VIA ZOOM: from this Sunday we will no longer be streaming Mass from St Catherine's. The livestream of Mass began during Covid to enable us to remain connected as a community. We are now exploring different ways for the sick and the housebound to share in our Sunday Liturgy.

FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Following Jesus' most explicit prediction of his suffering, the apostles James and John skip any thought of suffering and seem to think that there is going to be some kind of messianic coup. Convinced their leader will prevail, they are already considering the administration of the new regime; they lobby for first and second cabinet post. We can almost feel Jesus' weariness and exasperation as he listens to the request of the Zebedee brothers. Instead of granting their request, Jesus challenges them to drink the cup he will drink and undergo the baptism he will undergo. Here Jesus evokes the biblical image of the "cup of suffering," (Jeremiah 25:15-29 and the meaning of baptism as death by drowning (Romans 6: 3-4). He affirms that James and John will suffer greatly for their association with Jesus. Nevertheless, he refuses their request on the grounds that assigning such places is not his prerogative to give (which presumably belongs to his Father). Mark closes this programmatic rejection of "politics as usual" with one last recapitulation of power paradox: if the disciples wish to become "great" they must become servants.
